How the Search Box Works

Inserting search term(s) will lead you to specific Portal pages where the search term(s) appear. As most pages are lengthy and content-rich, you will have to scroll down the page to find the search term (s). To navigate more quickly on the page, you may wish to use search term(s) with your browser's "Find" utility.

It is important to note that the search term may appear in a number of different abstracts on the same page. The find will indicate only the first instance of the search term on the page. You will have to scroll all the way down to the bottom of the page to find all abstracts containing the same search words.

We regret that the search box will not work with Internet Explorer.

Some users may find that the built-in highlighting function does not work, in which case they should rely on their browser's "Find" button once they arrive on a particular page.
